Systems Research Academic Showcase

For the last two years we have run the Systems Research Academic Showcase. After continuing positive response and very positive feedback from delegates, we will be running the same competition at this year's ASEC.

The Systems Research Academic Showcase is a poster competition for academic research but, unlike other competitions, has a far wider remit that includes:

- Individual contributions, from full-time students researching systems engineering topics
- Group contributions, from academic research groups in specific universities
- Project contributions, such as EU and EPSRC projects. We welcome contributions that may consist of a collaboration of partners involved in a single research project.

There will be a maximum of ten posters accepted and the best five will be offered one complementary attendance at ASEC2016 (two-day registration plus one night's accommodation – includes event dinner). The attendee is expected to be available to discuss the poster with the judging panel.

The poster competition will be judged by a panel of industrial experts whose organisations will be sponsoring the competition.

The winning poster (as selected from the top five at the event by a judging panel) wins a prize of £200.

The INCOSE UK ASEC will provide an excellent forum for you, your group or project to tell the INCOSE UK community about your research. With funded places for the top five posters and a winner's prize up for grabs, this is an opportunity too good to miss!

Important deadlines:

- **5th June 2016** Submission of abstracts – abstracts should be between 250 and 300 words outlining your poster topic and main points. A shortlist of posters will be selected on the basis of the abstracts received.
- **10th July 2015** Submission of proposed poster - successful researchers will be asked to submit a single-page draft of their poster which should give a good indication of objectives, structure, main themes, supporting evidence, conclusions, etc. Final conference posters will be selected and notified by mid-June 2016.

Please remember that there are a number of funded places for the best five submissions!!

The selected researchers will also produce an overview of their research group for inclusion in the conference proceedings.
